We will leave SGS at 3:20pm. Students will be dropped off at Yokes on HWY 2 (9:00pm), SGS (9:30pm), or the Grocery Outlet at the northwest corner of Maple and 4th Ave (the parking lot across from the Chevron and McDonalds) (10:00pm).

Skiing and snowboarding is dangerous. The mountain is often foggy and the conditions can be icy and cold. This is not the place for non-skiers/snowboarders. Students are not always with an adult. They are expected to ski with a buddy and must check in with Melanie or Jim Tuck. They must bring appropriate clothing and equipment. <u>Helmets are required!</u>

Skis and snowboards must be dropped off at Metters by the morning of the ski bus.

Students may rent equipment for \$20.00. Then \$8.00 more for a helmet with gear rental or \$12.00 for just a helmet.

Lift ticket is \$20.00 and bus fare is \$10.00 so \$30.00 for the evening (\$10 if you have a season pass!) Extra costs are snacks and dinner.

If students want a lesson, we need to have a group of at least two all learning the same sport (skiing or snowboarding) and the cost is \$25.00 per person. I must know this the week before the ski bus.

The bus leaves SGS at 3:20pm and will drop students off at Yokes on HWY 2 at 9:00pm, SGS at 9:30pm and then the Grocery Outlet on the northwest corner of Maple and 4th Ave at 10:00pm (This is the parking lot that is across 4th Ave from the Chevron Station and McDonalds, a half block north of the west-bound on-ramp to the freeway).
